

Specifications for the Agility World Cup 2018 of the WDSF

Competitors will run three courses: Agility 1, Jumping, and Agility 2. In all runs, points can be won for an overall ranking per grade (FCI Grades 1, 2, and 3).

In each grade, the combination with the most points after three runs is the winner. The winner of Grade 3 wins the Agility World Cup 2018 of the WDSF and the NHC (Dutch breed club).

Agility 2 is a Combined Class, offering participants an opportunity to compete against each other regardless of grade. The course is identical for all grades, and has its own first, second, and third prize winners.

Awarding of Points

In all runs, points can be won to make up an overall ranking per grade. How many points are awarded depends on the number of participants in the grade, the result (the placing) and the number of course faults:

- 0 to 5 faults: 100% of the points corresponding to the result
- More than 5 faults to 10 faults: 50% of the points
- More than 10 faults to 15 faults: 20% of the points
- More than 15 faults: no points

The number of points is rounded up. For example, if a third place is worth 15 points but was gained with 6 faults, the number of points awarded is 8 (50% of 15 = 7.5 rounded up = 8).

Course faults: knockdowns, refusals, missed contact areas and such are 5 faults. Time faults are 1 fault per second that the standard course time (SCT) is exceeded.

Grade 1

In the Agility1, Jumping, and Agility 2 runs, points for the overall ranking can be won according to the following table:

Grade 2

In the Agility1, Jumping, and Agility 2 runs, points for the overall ranking can be won according to the following table:

Grade 3

In the Agility 1, Jumping, and Agility 2 runs, points for the overall ranking can be won according to the following table:

Place	Points
1st	35
2nd	30
3rd	25
4th	20
5th	15
6th	10
7th	5

In Grade 3, the STC is determined by the time of the fastest dog with the fewest course faults + 15% and rounded up to the nearest second.

Provided the respective FCI regulations are met, the first place winner of the Agility 1 course in Grade 3 will receive a certificate to request the **CACIAg**, and the second place winner will receive a certificate to request the **Reserve-CACIAg**.

Combined Class - Agility 2 Course

The Agility 2 course is a Combined Class: the course is the same for all competitors regardless of grade. Points can be won for the ranking per grade as described above. In addition, first, second, and third prizes are awarded for this course irrespective of the grade of the combination.

The starting order of the Agility 2 course is in reverse order of the ranking per grade after the first two runs, starting with grade 1, following by grade 2, and then grade 3.
